The Virginia Department of Education, Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services (DARS), and the Center on Transition Innovations (CTI) at VCU are seeking to partner with school divisions to improve transition services and postsecondary education and employment outcomes for at-risk high school students with disabilities pursuing a regular diploma.

Start on Success (SOS) is a yearlong school-to-work program that provides selected students with a Career and Technical Education course and a paid internship in the community with support from the school, mentors, families, community agencies, and a business. Since 2014, SOS has been implemented in multiple school divisions across Virginia. Applications will be accepted to expand to additional school divisions for the next school year.
