

Postsecondary Training Options: FastForward Career Training Program

FastForward is a short-term credential and certification workforce training program for the 40 most in-demand jobs across Virginia. FastForward programs are designed for those who would like to get a job or advance their career quickly and affordably. All 23 Virginia community colleges offer some FastForward in-person and online courses. Each college's course offerings are specific to the needs of its local community.

General Information

Age Requirements: Must meet the minimum age requirement of the qualifying training program.

Residential Requirements: Must be a continuous resident of Virginia for at least one year and meet the Virginia Domicile requirements.

Duration: Most programs take 6-12 weeks to complete and are designed so that participants can work while taking courses.

Costs: Costs vary depending on the program selected. FastForward Career Coaches are available to help find financial assistance.
